Title: Your Gifts – My Gifts- All Gifts

Scripture: 1 Corinthians 12 & 14

Questions:

1. What is the worst (or best) gift you have ever received for a special event in your life? (eg. Birthday, anniversary, retirement, moving...)
2. *A Spiritual Gift is a **supernatural ability** that God gives to **all** Christ followers, so that **together**, we can do **God's work** in the world.* How does this definition impact your perspective on spiritual gifts?
3. At Trinity we believe God gifted and designed each one of us in unique ways. Share your spiritual gifts (or what you think they are). Where has God placed you to use them today?
4. Verse 7 reads "*A spiritual gift is given to **each of us** so we can **help each other**.*" How has someone else's gift helped you
5. In his message, Scott mentioned how, through fear or lack of belief, he can limit what God might want to do in his life. Can you relate to that in your life? Why is this common for Christ followers? For you?

Prayer

Spend some time praying that God would reveal the gifts he has given you in a fresh way. Ask the Lord to show you how each group member can use their gifts. Ask to be humble, secure and strong as you pursue everything God has for you.

"God has given each of you a gift from his great variety of spiritual gifts. **Use them well to serve one another.**"¹¹ Do you have the gift of speaking? Then speak as though God himself were speaking through you. Do you have the gift of helping others? Do it with all the strength and energy that God supplies. Then **everything you do will bring glory to God** through Jesus Christ. All glory and power to him forever and ever! Amen."
