Title: Sing a Little Louder - Joy

Scripture: Psalm 145:7

Questions:

- 1. What's the first CD you ever owned? OR What's your favourite album and why?**
- 2. On the weekend, Mark, Kiko & Andrew shared stories about and a song that was significant in a specific season of their lives and how that has shaped the way they worship. Is there a song that has played a significant role in your story? What was it, and how did God use it in that season of your life?**
- 3. Read Psalm 145 out loud. What stands out to you from the verses? Why?**
- 4. In the Psalms, "David declares that God's people could not help but raise their hands in praise for God's faithfulness; they could not help but *yadah יָדָה* (Psalm 145:10) the Lord." (Holy Roar). How has God been faithful in your life?**
- 5. Reflecting on God's faithfulness stirs us to respond with worship - with joy for who He is and what He's done. What could it look like for you to continue to enter into intentional moments of musical worship this week?**

→ Make it a spiritual exercise. Pick a specific worship song and play it on repeat this week as an anthem of joyful praise.

→ The last 5 Psalms (Psalm 146-150) are Psalms of Praise. Read through them this week to prepare your heart for our time singing together as a community next weekend.

→ Mark our calendars and plan to come to the Prayer Summit at Trinity on Sunday June 2 for a night of intentional prayer and worship. (6:30 pm in The Refinery)
