SCRIPTURE: GRAB A BIBLE (OR BIBLE APP). CHOOSE ONE OR MORE OF THE WORDS FOR "PRAISE" FROM THE LIST OF HEBREW WORDS BELOW! READ THE PSALM USING THE DESCRIPTION IN PLACE OF "PRAISE" (DON'T WORRY ABOUT PRONOUNCING THEM RIGHT):

- **PSALM 67:3 - YADAH** = TO REVERE OR WORSHIP WITH EXTENDED HANDS
- **PSALM 149:3 - HALAL** = TO BOAST. TO RAVE. TO CELEBRATE. TO BE CLAMOROUSLY FOOLISH.
- **PSALM 22:3 - TEHILLAH** = EXUBERANT SINGING. A SPONTANEOUS SONG. A NEW SONG
- **PSALM 56:11-12 - TOWDAH** = TO LIFT HANDS IN ADORATION. THANKSGIVING FOR THINGS NOT YET RECEIVED. A SACRIFICE OF PRAISE.
- **PSALM 144:9 - ZAMAR** = TO MAKE MUSIC. TO CELEBRATE IN SONG AND MUSIC. TO TOUCH THE STRINGS OR PARTS OF A MUSICAL INSTRUMENT.
- **PSALM 72:11 & 15 - BARAK** = TO BLESS BY KNEELING OR BOWING
- **PSALM 145:4 - SHABACH** = TO ADDRESS IN A LOUD TONE. TO SHOUT
