



# COVID-19 SAFETY PLAN

## **REGISTRATION & ATTENDANCE**

- Students are encouraged to register ahead of attending youth. Registration links are available [on our web page here.](#)
- A 50 patron capacity limit exists for each building on campus. This is why it's so important for students to register ahead of time, and to let us know if they aren't able to attend so that another student may participate.
- Students may show up at the door and complete the registration process - pending availability for that evening.
- Vaccine passports are currently not required to attend Trinity Church Youth functions. We ask that all attendees of our events and experiences carefully monitor their health and choose not attend in person if they are feeling unwell.

## **BUILDINGS AND CAPACITY**

- Doorways and hallways are clearly marked with where to walk and which areas are off limits to the public. Our auditorium is currently undergoing renovations and is an active worksite. Students are asked to follow all signage and directions from the youth staff, and volunteer team, to avoid both building crossover and construction areas.
- When students arrive at Youth they will be checked in at the tents in the courtyard. Because our Youth nights look different week to week, volunteers will give direction to which building each student's group is meeting in that night.

## **MASKS AND PHYSICAL DISTANCING**

- Masks are required for all students, staff, and volunteers when indoors. This includes lobbies, hallways, bathrooms, and large group spaces. Masks may be removed in small group rooms at the discretion of our Small Group Leaders.
- All students and leaders are asked to follow social distancing guidelines at all times.
